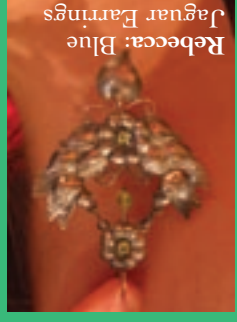

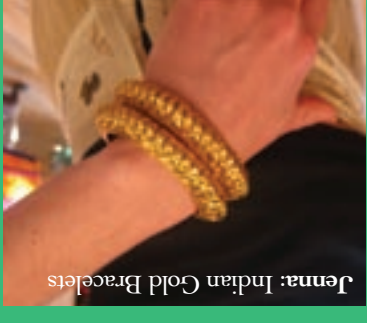

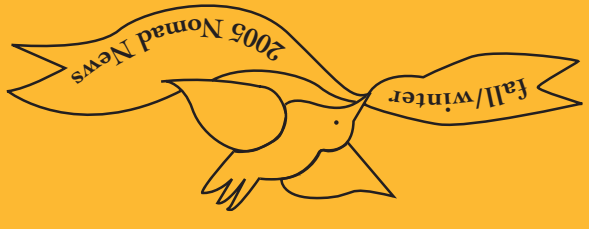

## Day of the Dead!

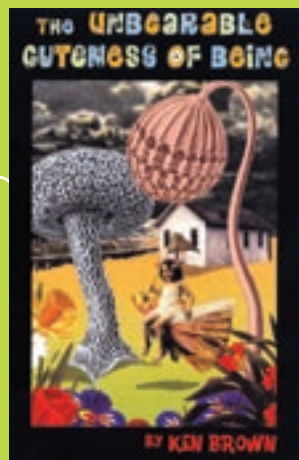
Wednesday, November 2nd, 6:00 - 8:00 pm
